Aleatory: *Relating to or denoting music or other forms of art involving elements of random choice or chance, during their composition, production or performance.*

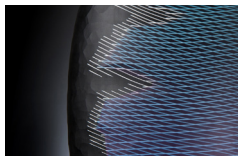
