Receptive Vessels

Adi Toch is an award-winning metalsmith whose practice centres on making engaging vessels and containers that investigate movement, sound and tactility.

Receptive Vessels explores the relationship between the spectator and a potentially sentient object through a sensitive and surprising interaction. The viewers are encouraged to speak or sing - in order to trigger the vessels' reaction. The installation suggests a playful interpretation of museum displays, an experience that is an antidote to the traditionally hushed gallery environment.

This experimental display is part of an ongoing project based on new research by Toch and developed in collaboration with sound specialists John Henry's Ltd.
