Ceramicist Annie Turner used to collect mussels from the foreshore of the River Deben in Suffolk with her father. She drew on her memories to create these stoneware mussel cups, which are imprinted with detritus found while out walking, including fossilised shark's teeth and feathers. Lightly coloured and delicately finished, they are like the riverbank in miniature, refracted through the eye of the artist and her recollections.
